According to American agency FIB crime rate on internet during lockdown has increased 400 % as most of the world is working online. Also the maximum complainant was females. In order to spread awareness about different ways in which the specialized crime is being committed an online webinar on "Crime against Women" at 11:30 AM. Event was organized by Indore Police, under the guidance of Inspector General of Police Mr. Harinarayan Chari. Prof Gaurav Rawal, cyber-crime trainer gave insights about what is cyber-crime and how attackers commit it against women; different types in which hackers commit crime like financial frauds, social media frauds.



He explained the prevention during the use of different electronics gadgets. He specifically stated the IT acts and urged to be aware and spread the awareness. At last he mentioned to report crime to right person and shared helpline numbers also.
