1. Restricted entry of automobiles:

The college operates a fleet of 22 buses covering each corner of Indore to facilitate the students. The college buses are checked for pollution by the authorized agency. For two wheelers or four wheelers, security measures are mandatory. As the institution campus is in the Centre of the city so mostly the student prefers local transportation i.e., AICTSL City Bus. Institution's majority student strength comes from other cities so,

- (I) They prefer college hostel therefore they are not using any vehicles.
- (II) The student living outside the campus prefers public transports (AICTSL City Bus). As the fuel price are so high it is economically feasible for the student to adopt this facility by city administration.

The faculty also prefer sharing of vehicle when they are coming from same areas. When the faculties are coming on same time (any events), mostly they prefer to come along with the colleagues it make the runway cost-efficient, safe and Eco-friendly.

1. Pedestrian Friendly pathways:

Vehicle parking space is provided at the main entrance of the college campus. As the campus is vehicle free with some exceptions, students and staff experience comfort walking through the pedestrian friendly pathways. The internal roads are lined with trees and they are properly maintained by the campus maintenance committee. These pathways are used in morning (6.00 am- 7.30 am.) and evening time (6.00 pm. to 8.00 pm.) as a walking and running track. The pedestrian track is fully surround by 13 feet and 8 feet green area which gives the track a greener look. The total area for pedestrian's pathway is 356* 18 feet.

4. Ban on use of plastic:

Single-use plastic items such as plastic bottles, bags, spoons, straws and cups are banned completely and awareness is created among staff and students through orientation and display boards in the premises. To restrict the use of plastic, measures have been taken to replace plastic tea cups and glasses with steel glasses in the canteen. The staff and students are informed to use steel or copper water bottles instead of plastic bottles.

5. Landscaping with trees and plants.

Landscaping of the college is worth seeing and reflects aesthetic sense. The institute has a canopy of trees and plants to make the environment pollution free to safeguard the health of all the inmates. The lawns and the trees provide shade and beautiful ambience. Utmost care is taken to develop and maintain green landscaping by trained gardeners and supervisor. The construction and maintenance committee constituted in the college looks after the development and maintenance of the greenery in the campus.


